NOTICE TO CONSUMERS:

REGISTRATION OF INDIGENT

Dr Nkosazana Dlamini-Zuma Municipality has adopted the Indigent Policy to assist members of the community who cannot afford the full cost of services provided by the Municipality. Households who are unable to pay for their assessment rates and services (including prepaid electricity) accounts and who are interested in applying for indigent status must conform to the following criteria:

- 1. Households where verified total gross monthly income of all occupants over 18 years of age does not exceed a **total equivalent of two (2) state pensions.**
- 2. Have proof of payslips if they are employed and earning as above 1.
- 3. Submit a copy of recent bond statement and three months bank statement where applicable.
- 4. Not own more than one property.

An application shall be made on the prescribe application form which is obtainable from Municipal Offices (Creighton, Bulwer Library, Underberg library and Himeville offices), Ward Councilors, CDW's and Ward Committees.

Closing Date: All completed applications must reach the Municipal Offices by **28 February 2022** and shall be accompanied by above listed documents. A sworn affidavit stating that gross total household income of all persons ordinary residing at above concerned and all documents accompanying the application are true and correct. Any registration of consumers as indigent expires, without further notice on **30 June 2022**.
